

Are you enrolled in Medicare?

As a “Non-Participating Provider” with Medicare, we are required to verify the coverage status of any Medicare-age patient which we treat. For this reason we will ask for your Medicare ID number so that we can verify this with the Medicare website. If the Medicare website shows that you are not enrolled in Medicare then you will be treated as a Private Pay patient.

If you are enrolled in Medicare then we will need for you to supply us with a copy of your Medicare card.

Does your coverage include Part B (Professional coverage for Doctor visits)? YES NO

If the answer is no... then you will be treated as a Private Pay patient.

Have you chosen a Medicare Replacement Insurance Plan to handle your Medicare benefits for you? YES NO
